## Guía para Charla 2

Charla 2 will be held Monday, November 19 (11:00-12:00) and Tuesday, November 20 from (11:00-1:00) in my office (Kauke 209). Students may choose their partners for this Charla. The Charla should be approximately 5 minutes long.

Students will choose one of the following prompts and develop a conversation based on that prompt.

- 1) Student A is a famous person. Student B is a talk-show host. The talk-show host is interviewing the famous person about every detail of his/her life and work. This can include information about his/her family, daily routines, plans for the future, things he/she did in the past, etc. This can be based on an actual famous person or it can be made up.
- 2) Student A is planning a trip abroad to Spain. Student B studied abroad in Spain last semester. Student A calls Student B for some advice. They talk about what items and clothing the student should bring, what the weather is like, what the city is like, etc. Student A explains what activities he/she is planning on doing and Student B describes the activities he/she did.
- 3) Students A and B are planning a family reunion. Student A is the family member everyone gets along with. He/she is very easygoing and never gets upset with anyone. Student B is the exact opposite. He/she always finds something to complain about and is always upset with someone in the family. The students discuss the details of the reunion location, who to invite, activities to organize, food to serve, etc. They also talk about what happened at past family reunions.

As with the last Charla, you will be graded on the following aspects:

- correct grammar and vocabulary usage
- ease of communication
- avoiding extended pauses
- correct pronunciation
- being comprehensible

Each student may bring a note card with 10 single words (no sentences) written on it. This is to help jog your memory should you lose your place. However, you are not to read from the note cards.
